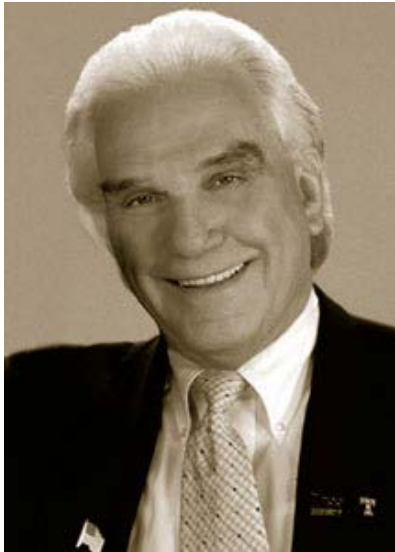

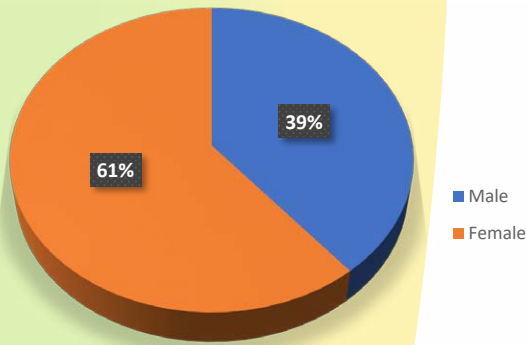

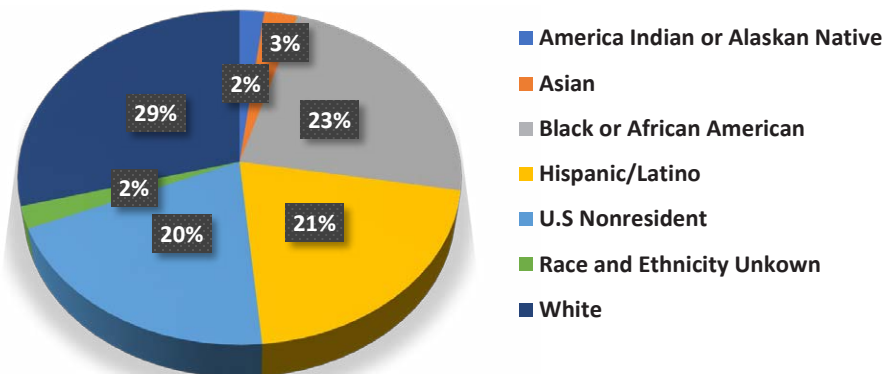
Athletes by Gender

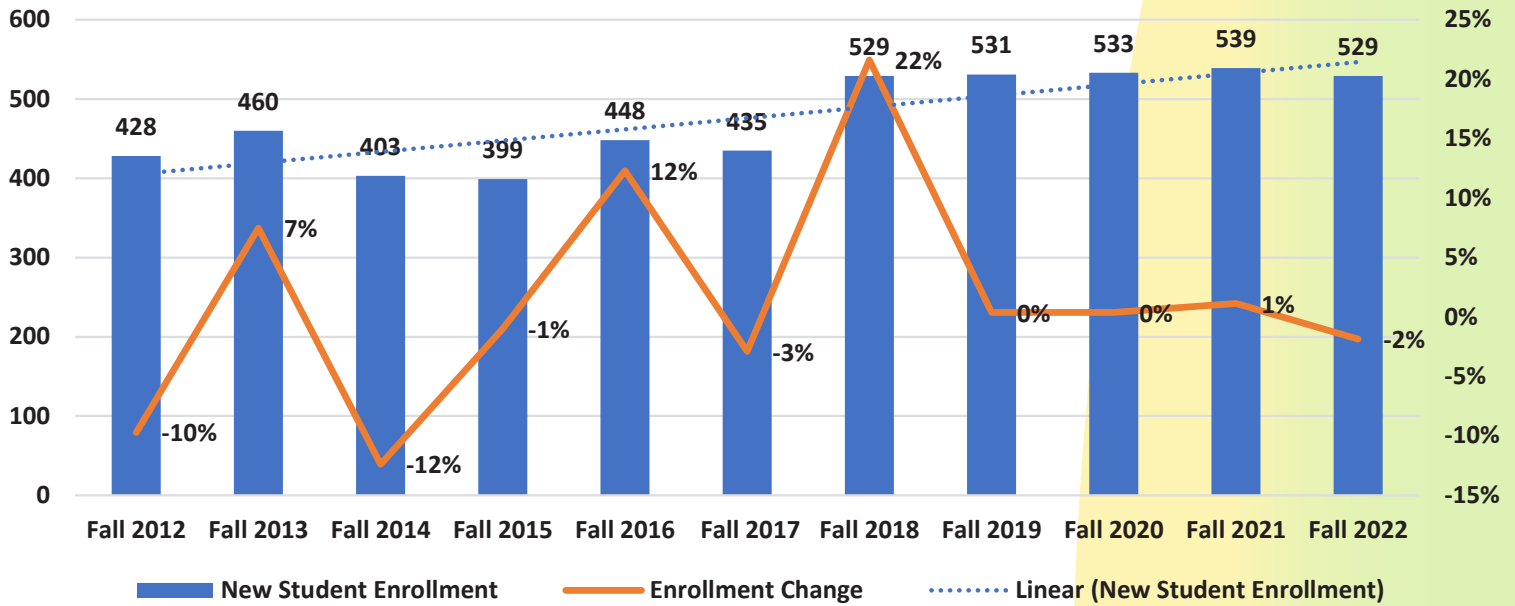

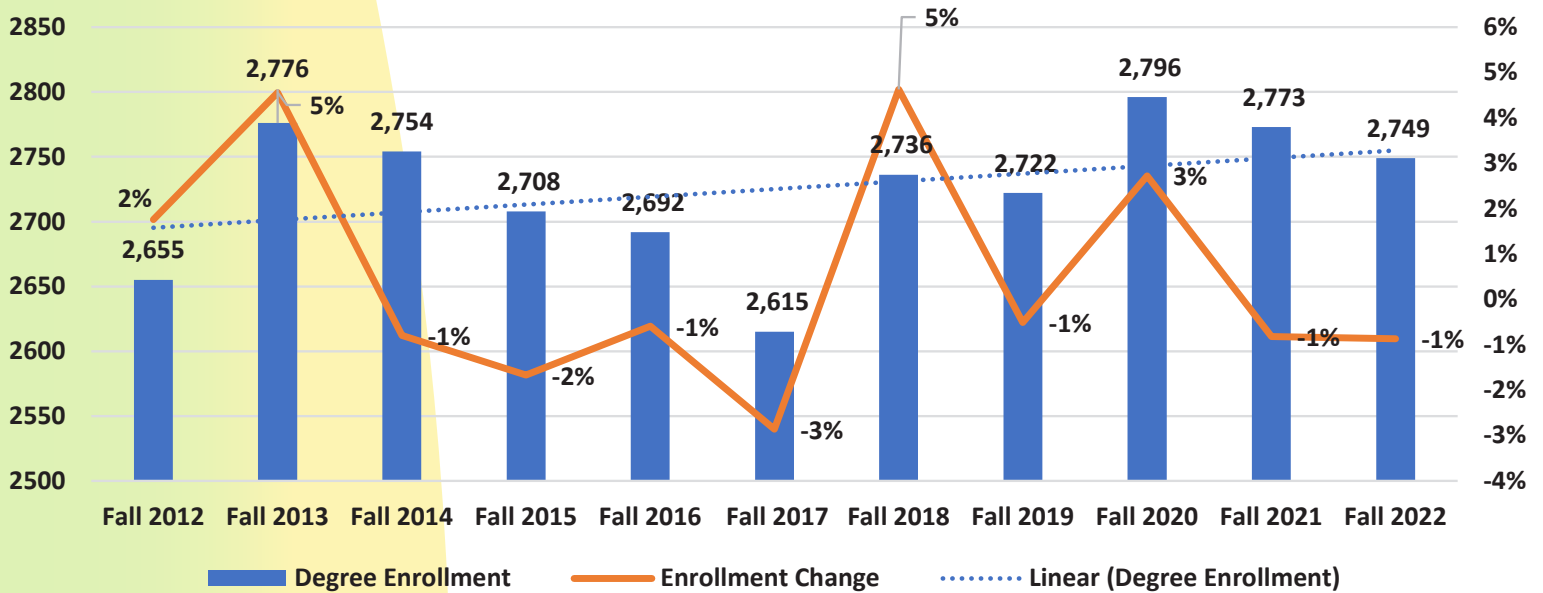

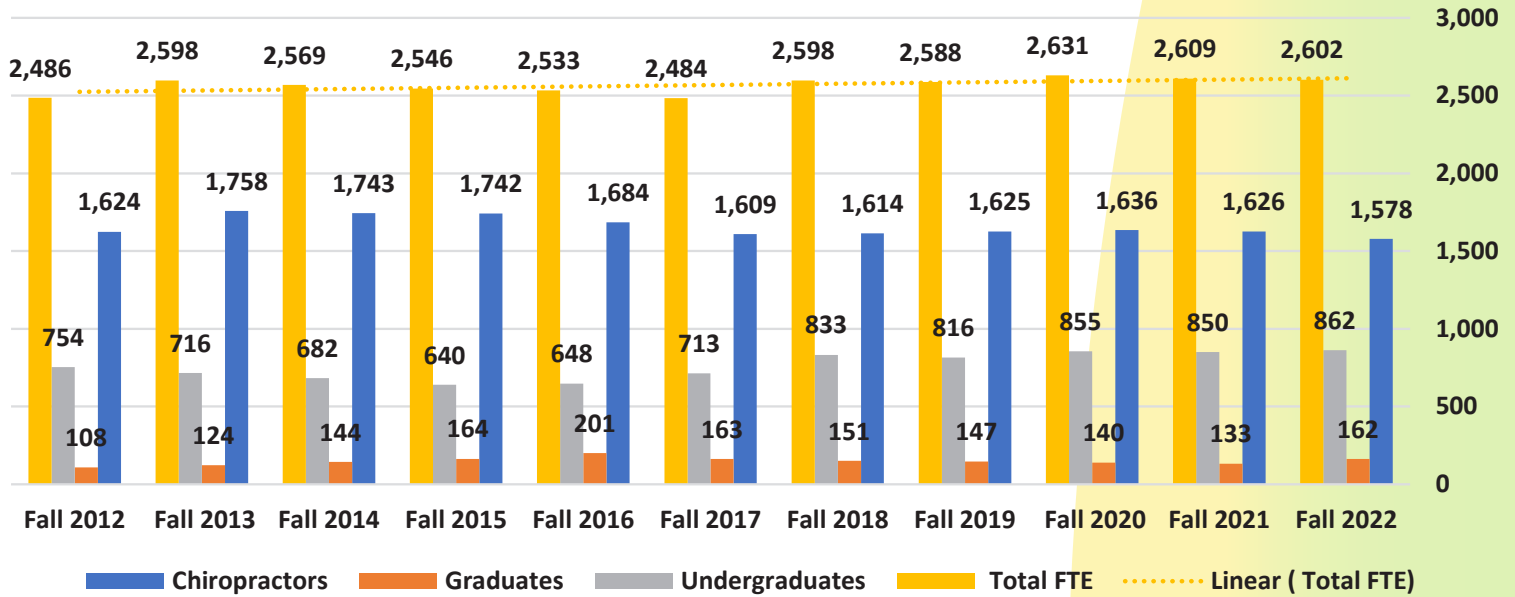

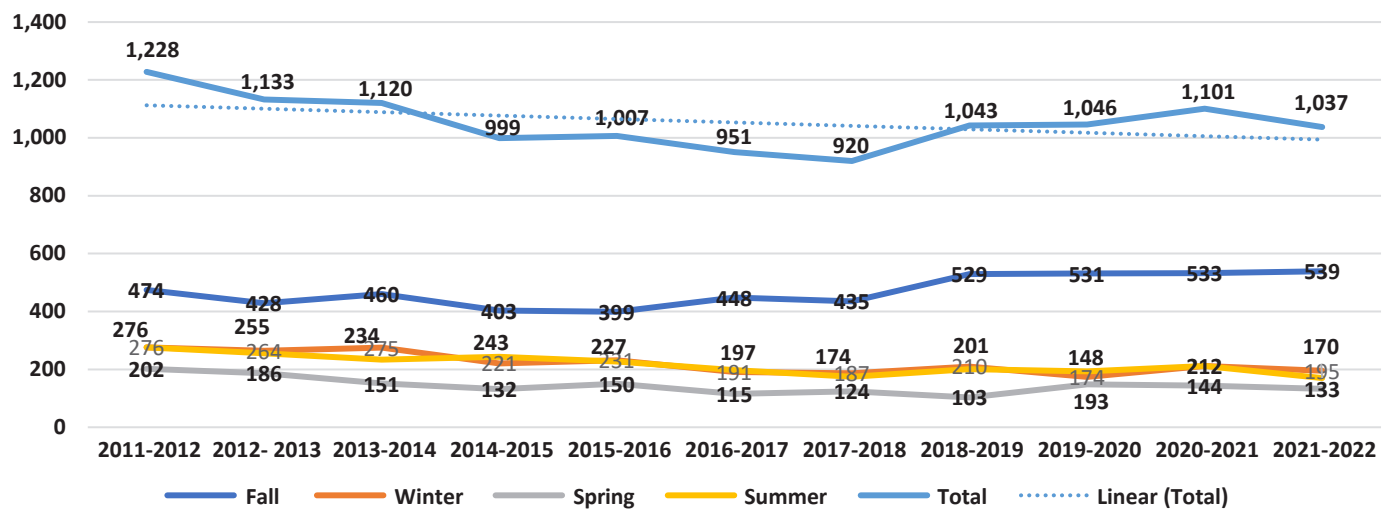

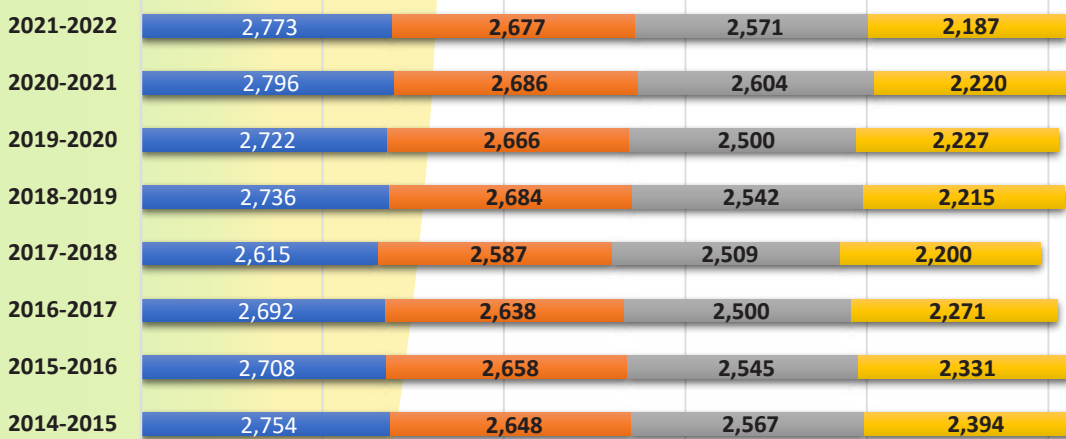

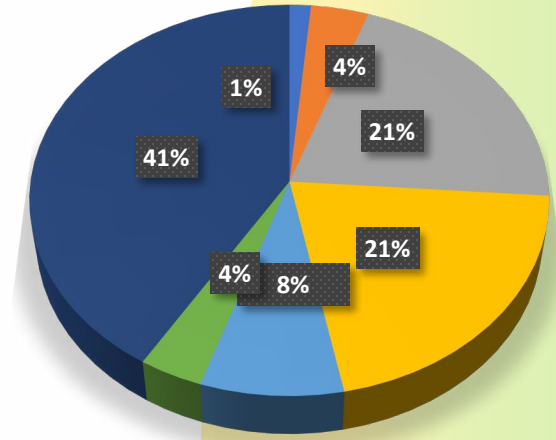

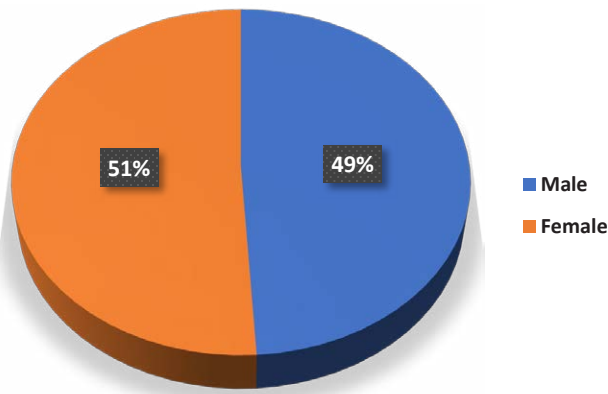

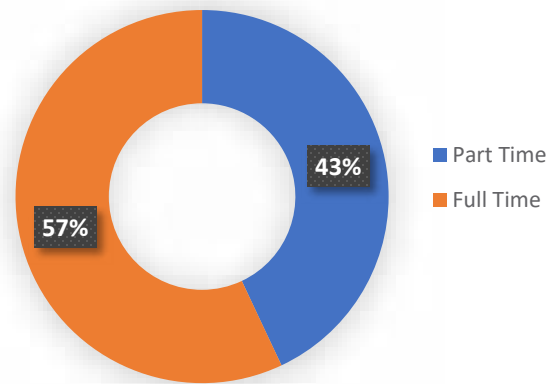

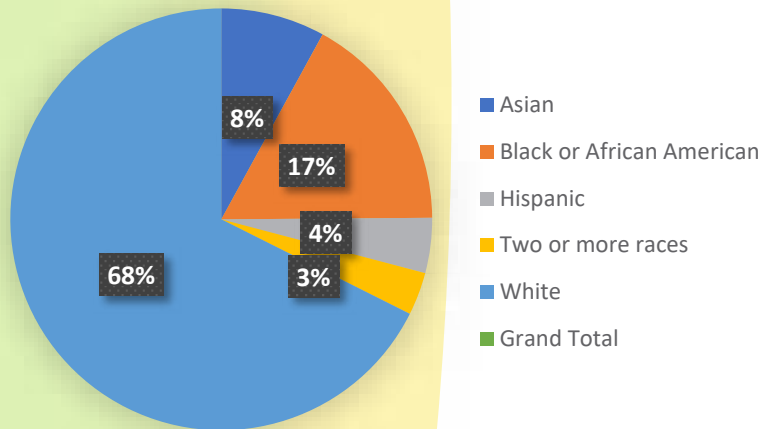

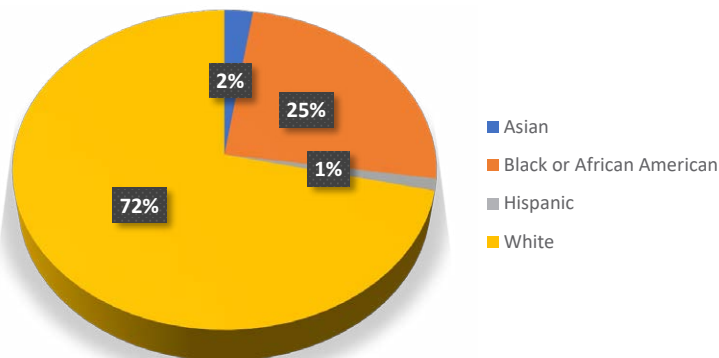

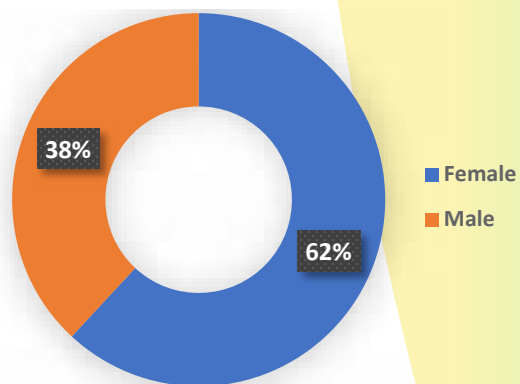

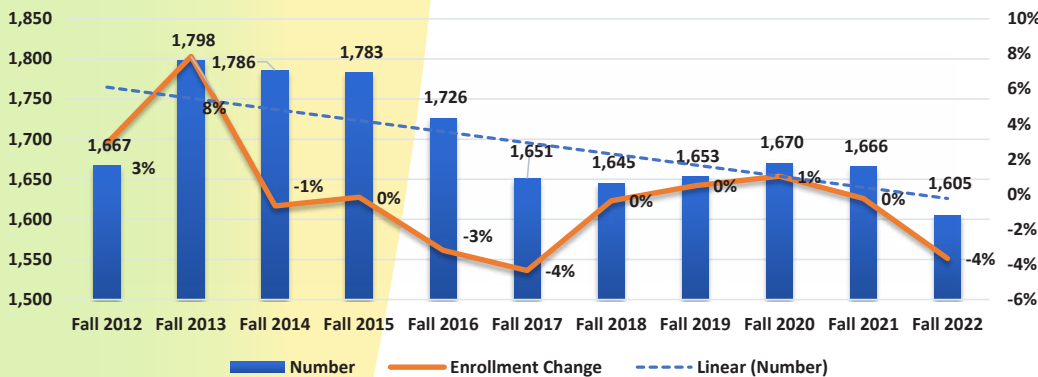

COC Enrollment Trend



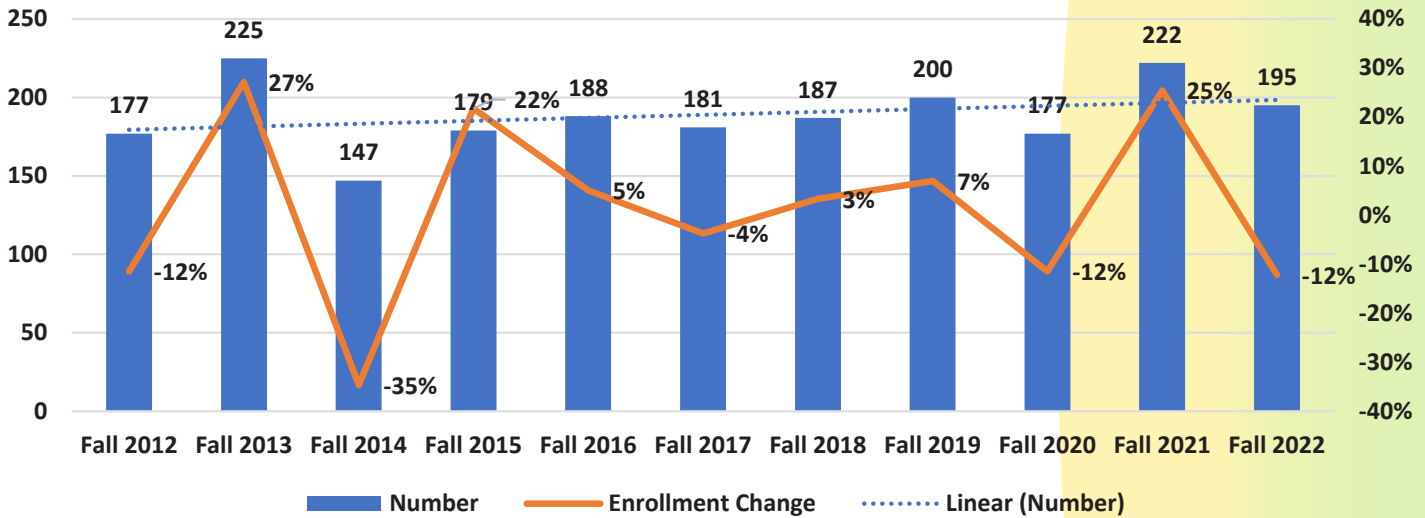

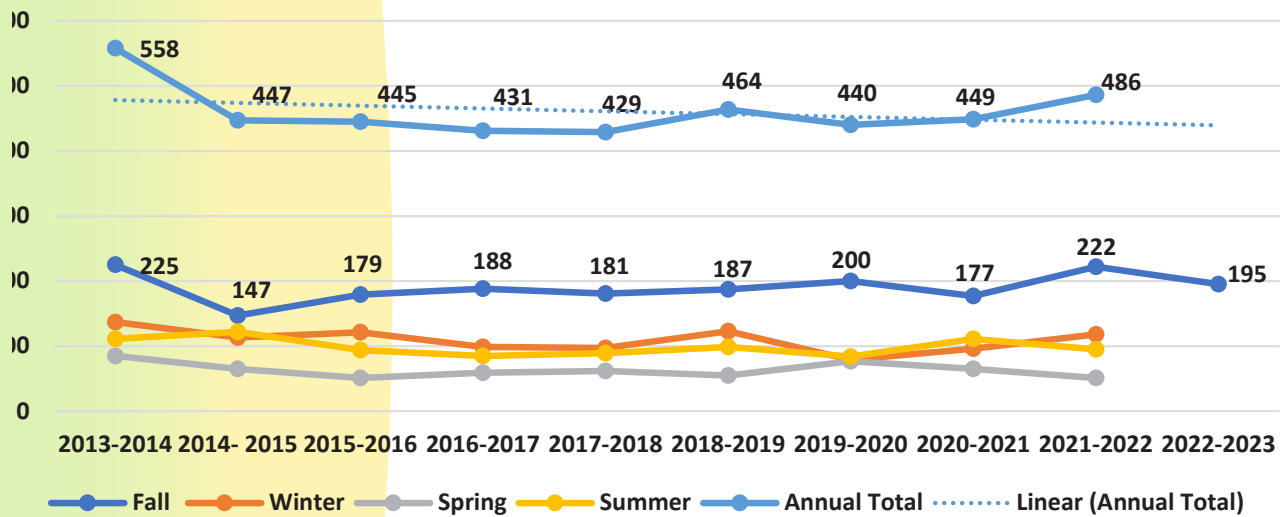

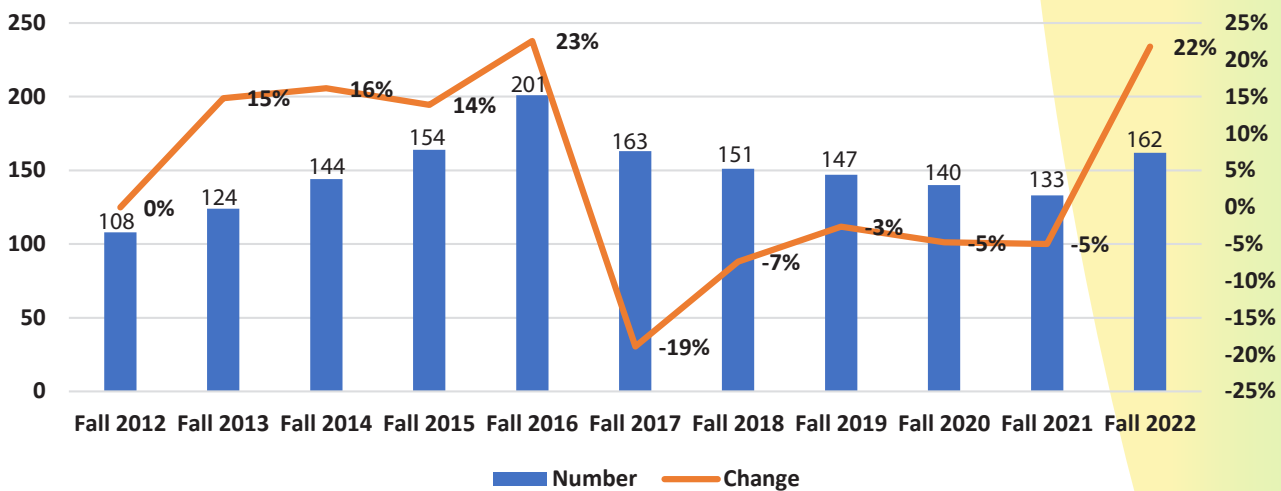

Combined Graduate FTE



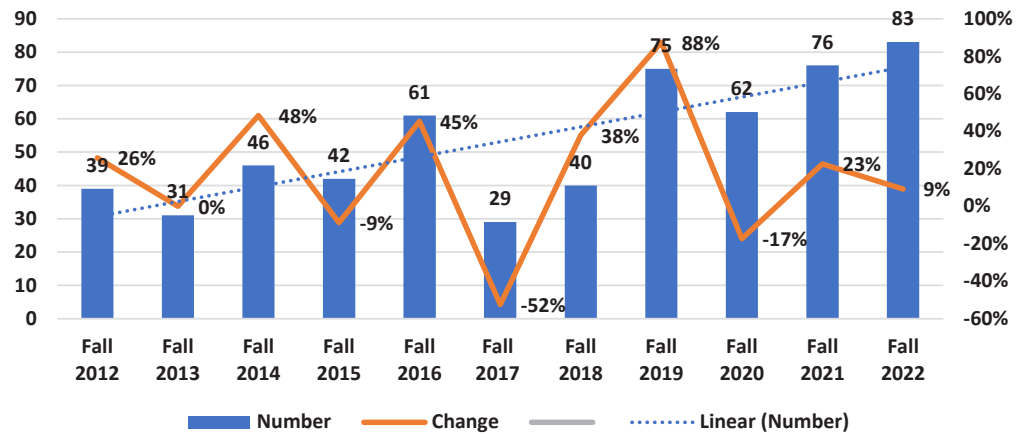

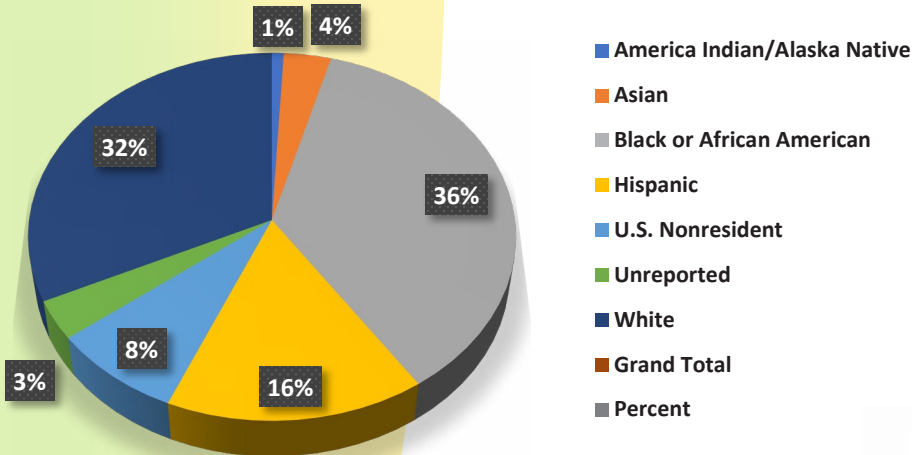

Quarter Enrollment All Undergraduates



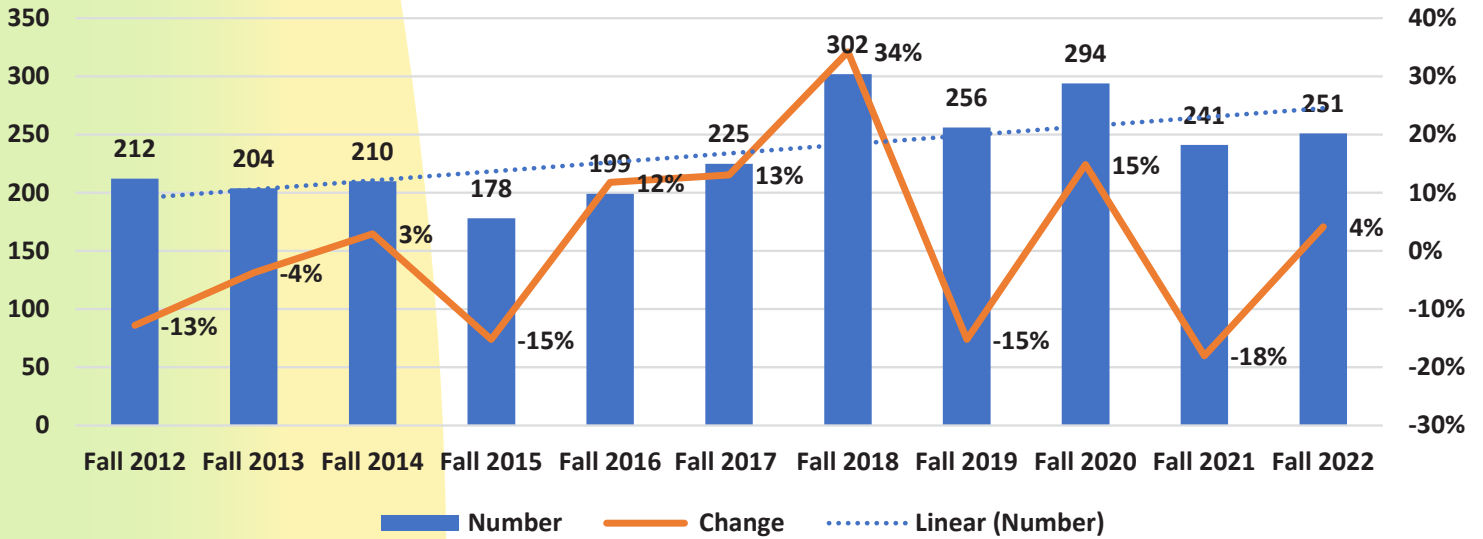

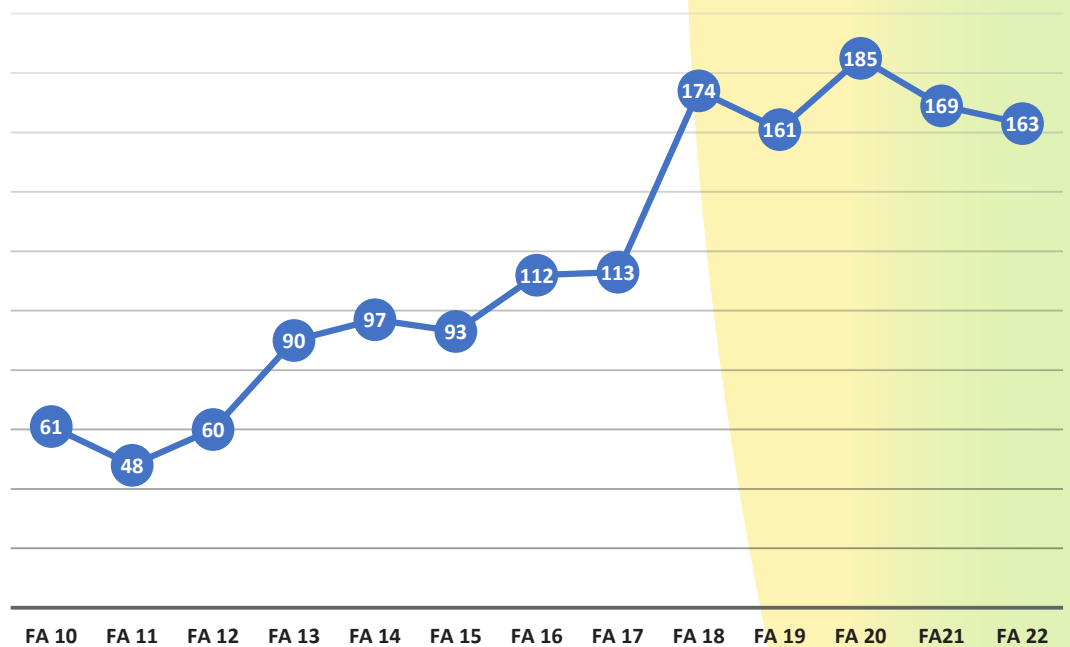

Degrees Conferred Trend

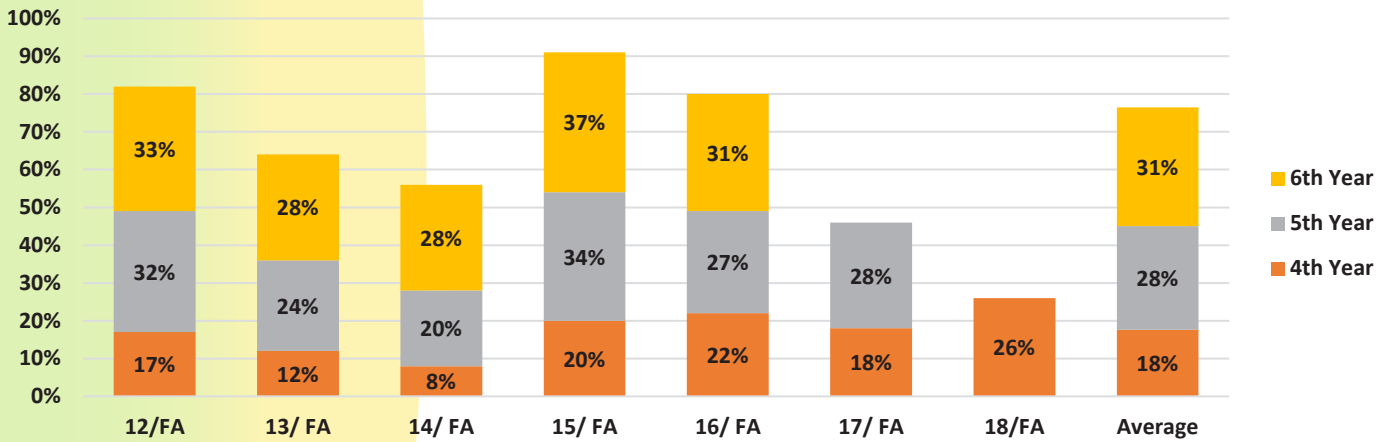
